

Hurricane Boarding Policy

Dr. K's Animal Hospital, Inc. has been built according to current hurricane building codes. Dr. K's Animal Hospital Inc. holds itself harmless and not liable in the following conditions:

1. Failure of structure or its components due to natural causes: wind, rain, flying debris, flooding or fire, etc.
2. Any infections or contagious diseases or external or internal parasites.
3. Stressful behavior of animal leading to self injury or death due to underlying illness. We strongly recommend that pets with serious illnesses, on continuous medication, or in the need of close observation, travel outside the affected area, so that proper medication and care can be taken until the situation normalizes.
4. We recommend that you DO NOT bring bedding, belongings, or toys. Any loss of items will not be compensated.
5. We are the first hospital in the area with standard industrial generator able to run electric powered appliances. We are not liable if there is a lack of availability of fuel or sudden failure of equipment as a result of #1, #2, #3.
6. All animals must enter the boarding first reserved first come basis. Dr. K's Animal Hospital will cease to accept boarders one day before the expected land fall/arrival of storm at 10 a.m.
7. All animals must be properly vaccinated and tested for parasites as per hospital policy. NO PETS WITH TICKS WILL BE ADMITTED FOR BOARDING. All pets must be on frontline/advantage or similar veterinarian/hospital approved products. Proof is required to show that the pet is on a preventative (purchase records from hospital, box, etc.) If there is any doubt that the pet is not on treatment or if the client fails to show proof, we will apply a treatment.
8. Please be understanding. The staff are also human beings. If hurricane winds exceed Category 3, no human may be allowed to stay in the building as per the warning of authorities.
9. A minimum charge for 4 days is required because the staff works around the clock extra during disaster situations.
10. There is a \$7.60 subcharge per day per pet for the maintenance and running of the generator, food, staff and other consumables.
11. No animal will be released from the care of Dr. K's Animal Hospital during or immediately after the storm. IF POSSIBLE, please call Dr. K's Animal Hospital to find out the status of pet release.
